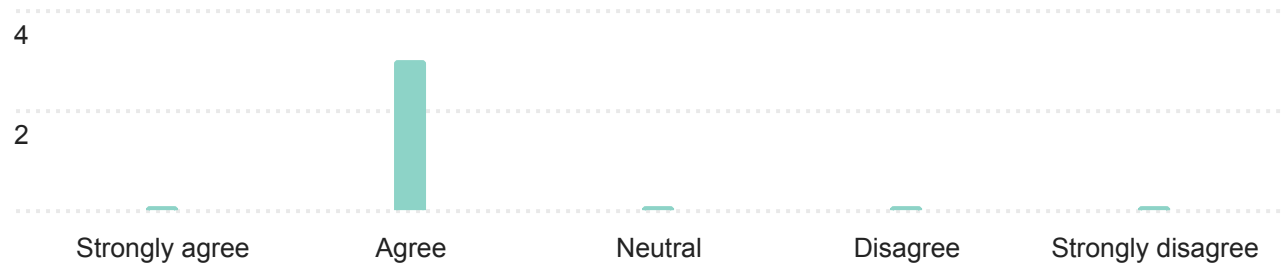

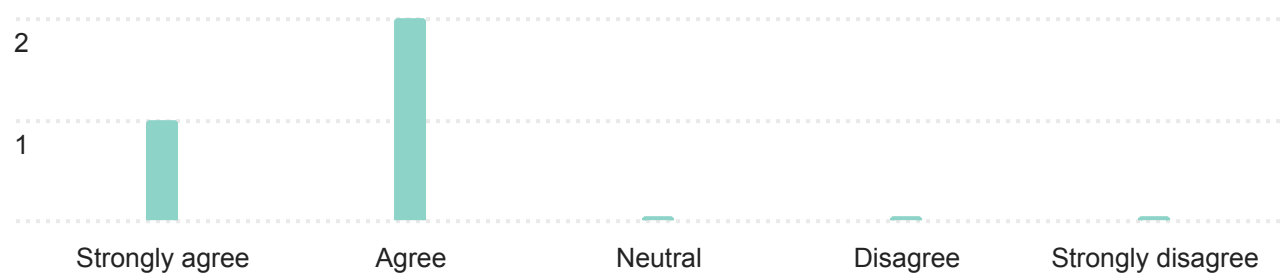

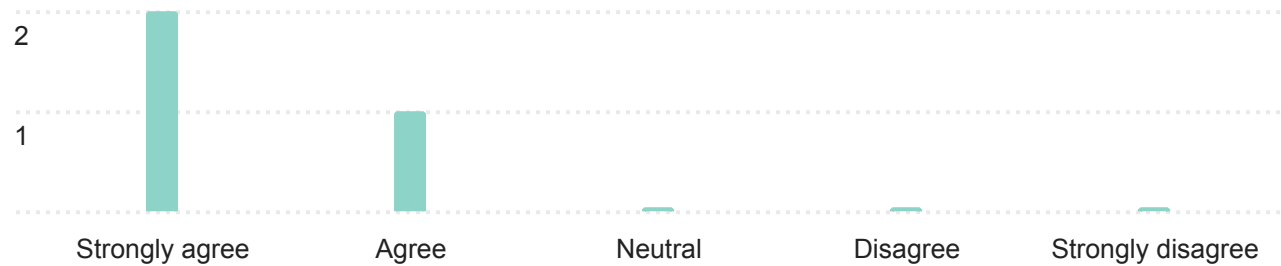
The information provided by the placement provider was helpful.



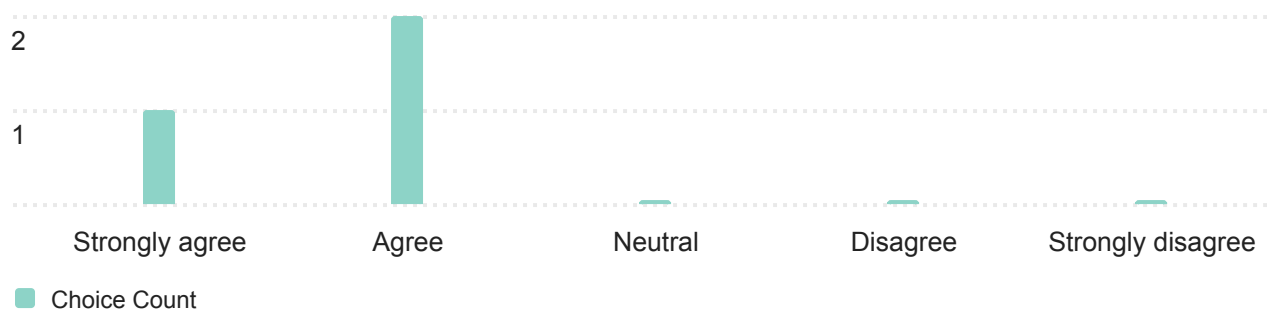
I felt prepared for the placement and was orientated to the learning environment.



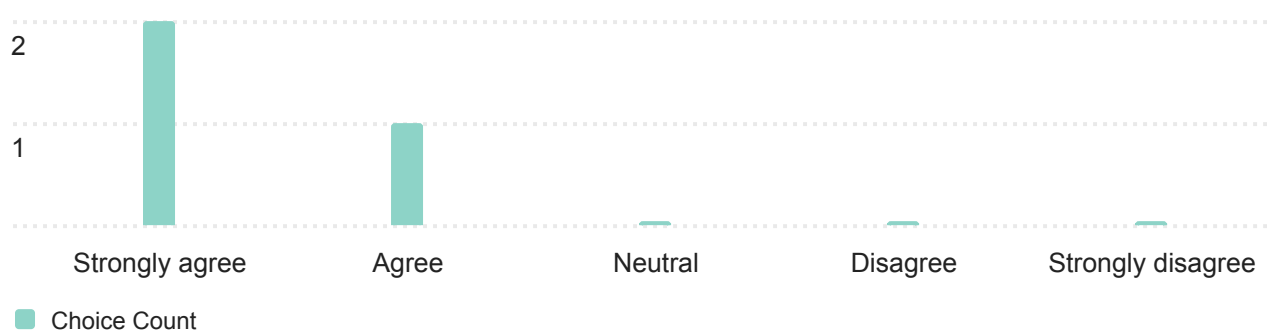
The placement's culture was a welcoming environment.

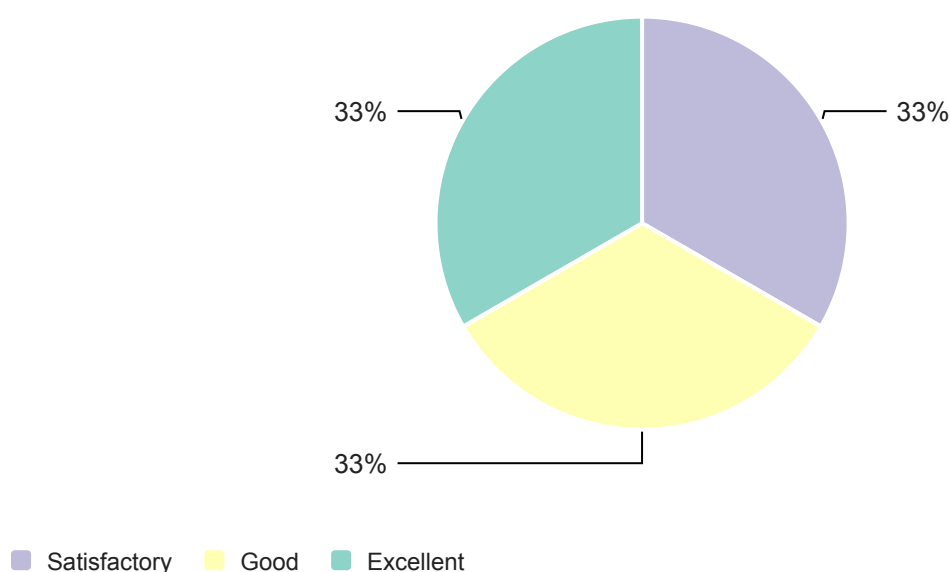
